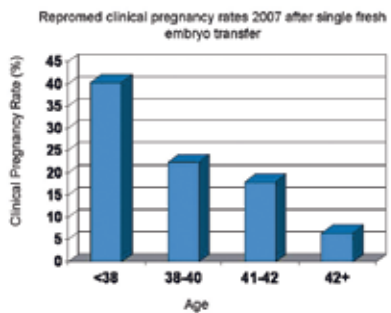
Beating
the clock

Everybody has a clock

Both men and women have a reproductive lifespan or biological clock. Women are born with all the eggs they will ever produce, so age is an important fertility factor. A woman's fertility declines slightly at 30 years of age and significantly around 37-38 years of age. At the age of 40, a woman's fertility is around a quarter of when she was 30 and she has a one in two chance of miscarriage compared to one in seven for a 25 year old.

Even when a woman is young and she and her partner are actively trying to conceive, increased paternal age has a significant effect on the time it takes to conceive. Men over 45 years take five times as long to conceive with their young partners than men aged less than 25 years.
