REPROMED MAKES OFFER TO DEFENCE PERSONNEL

Australian soldiers serving overseas will be able to have their semen frozen at no charge following an offer by Repromed, the largest in-vitro fertilisation specialist in SA and the NT. This is in line with its affiliate Monash IVF.

The offer by Repromed follows a government decision to no longer pay for the storage of semen of fertile Australian Defence Force personnel serving overseas.

Repromed Medical Director Richard Henshaw says he would be happy for the company to provide this service for any defence force staff prior to them serving overseas on active duty.

Dr Henshaw says that, while the men will need to comply with the SA and NT laws in relation to semen storage and use, Repromed would be happy to freeze and store semen for members of the defence forces at no charge for up to three years.

“This is the least we can do for these people,” he adds.
